

CLASSROOM ACHIEVEMENT BULLETIN BOARD

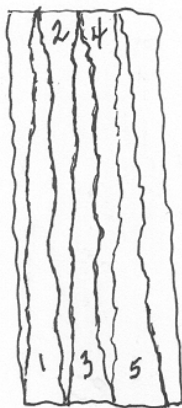
You can put this bulletin board up in the Fall and use it the whole school year. Each student has their own branch on the tree. At the beginning of the year the student puts an apple cut-out on their branch with their name and their picture on it. As a student completes a unit of study, learns a Hebrew prayer, etc. he/she writes the task on a leaf cut-out and puts the leaf on his/her branch. At the end of the year each student can take their branch home.

Materials Needed:

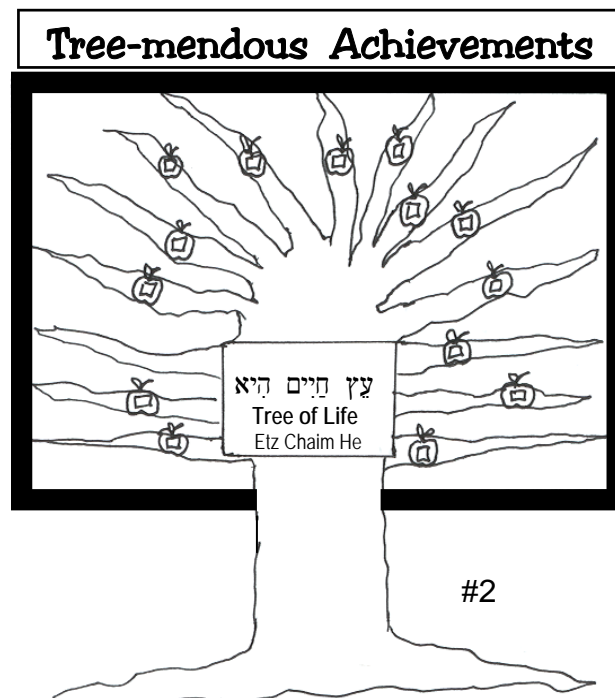
- large bulletin board
- large brown paper bags
- background poster paper for bulletin board
- apple and leaf cut-outs (die cuts available at CAJE)
- alphabet die cut letters for the title (available in 2" and 3" at CAJE)
- student pictures (send home letter asking students to bring a picture of themselves)
- stapler
- 3M Removable Wall Mounting Tabs
- glue sticks

Procedure:

1. Cut seams open on bags, crumple bags,.
2. Tear bags into shapes of branches (one per student). #1
3. Tear bags to form the shape of roots and trunk. The trunk and roots can go below the bulletin board. Use 3M Removable Wall Mounting Tabs to tape to wall.
4. Cover background of bulletin board with poster paper.
5. Put trunk and roots below bulletin board. Put branches on the bulletin board and connect to the trunk using a stapler. #2
6. Staple title letters above the tree and the Hebrew sign on the trunk of the tree. #2
7. Have students cut their picture so it fits on the their apple. It must be small enough so they can print their name on the apple above or below the picture. #3
