

JONAH AND THE WHALE

Materials needed:

- 12" x 18" gray construction paper
- 12" x 18" blue construction paper
- 3" x 6" white drawing paper
- markers
- scissors
- glue

Directions:

1. Fold and cut gray paper to size for younger children. Mark lines on gray paper for children that can do their own cutting. Fig 1
2. Have child cut out whale along pre-drawn lines.
3. Mark fold line and fold tail up. Fig. 2
4. Draw eyes and mouth on whale. Fig. 3
5. Draw a picture of Jonah on the small piece of white drawing paper.
6. Cut out picture of Jonah. Lift top of whale and glue Jonah inside of the whale. (Younger children can glue the small piece of white paper without cutting around Jonah.)

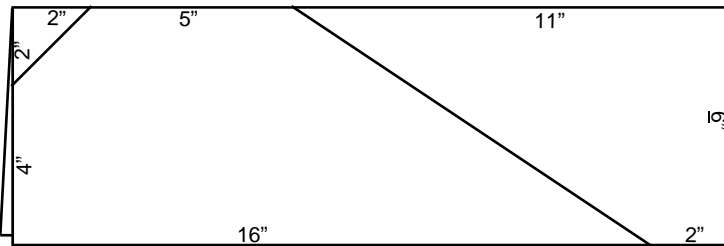

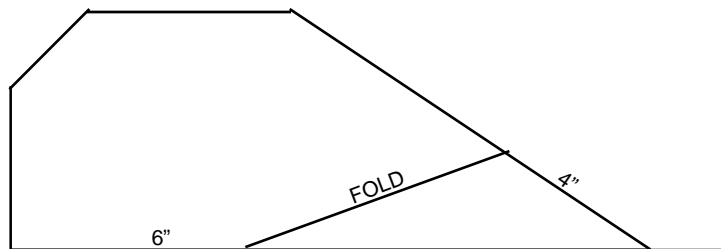
