

Assembly Directions for Road To Shushan

Cut around the outside edge of the blue border and glue playing directions on the front of a file folder or on a 11" x 17" piece of construction paper folded in half. Cut off dotted line strips on the two game board sheets and glue the sheets inside of the file folder or folded construction paper. *Leave a small space between the two inside sheets so the game board will fold.* Laminate the game board and cards. Trim the laminate and cut the laminated cards apart.

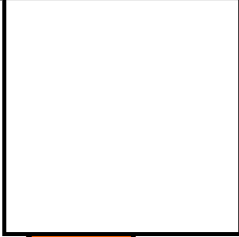
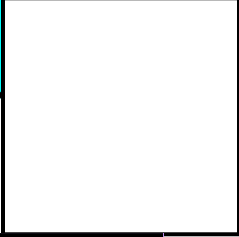
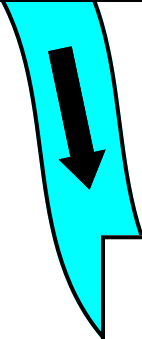
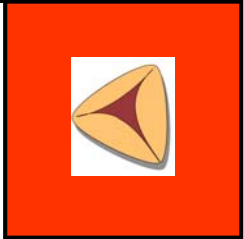
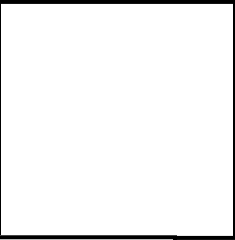
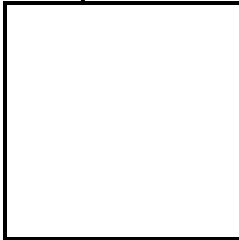
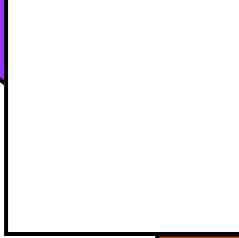
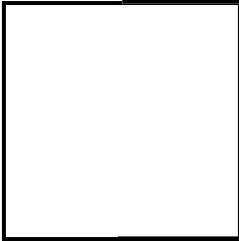
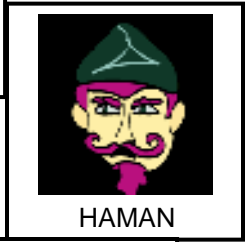
OBJECT OF THE GAME: Be the first to get to "SHUSHAN"

MATERIALS NEEDED: gameboard, game cards, 1 pawn per player

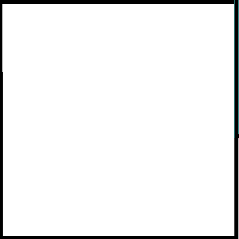
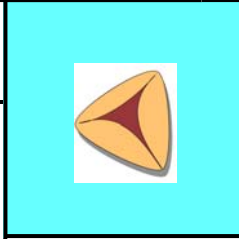
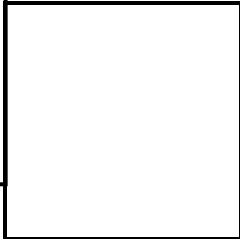
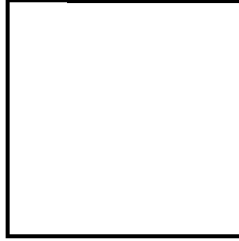
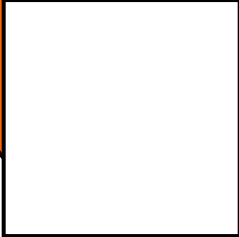
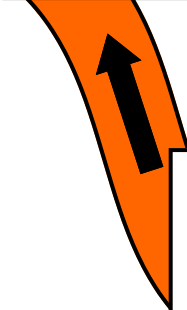
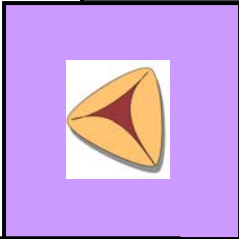
